Brant Rosen

Brant Rosen is the Rabbi of the Jewish Reconstructionist Congregation in Evanston and past president of the Reconstructionist Rabbinical Congregation. Rabbi Rosen is author of the popular blog *Shalom Rav*. He is co-founder of an ongoing solidarity awareness project, *Ta'anit Tzedek / the Jewish Fast for Gaza*. Rosen's editorials have appeared in various publications, including the *Chicago Tribune* and he has been listed by *Newsweek* as one of the top 25 pulpit rabbis in America.

Shirien Damra

Shirien Damra is a Palestinian-American born in Chicago. She is a graduate student of Sociology at DePaul University, focusing on political sociology of

the Middle East. She graduated with a BA in Sociology with a minor International Politics in 2009 at DePaul and continues to be a key activist in DePaul's Students for Justice in Palestine organization. She is also on the executive board for the Chicago chapter of the American Association for Palestinian Equal Rights (AAPER). Shirien made her first trip to Palestine in the summer of 2010.
